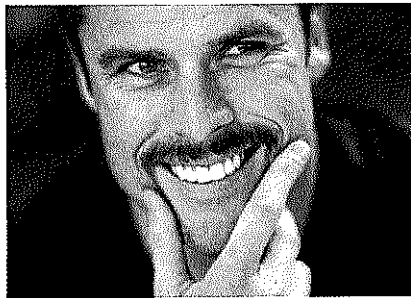
Regional awards for entrepreneurs
